

KINGSTON UNIVERSITY STUDY ABROAD / INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

Please read through the following Kingston University terms and conditions. By accepting your place then you are agreeing to the following. I understand that:

- 1. Kingston University and my home university reserve the right to terminate my participation in the programme on academic or personal grounds at any time.
- 2. As a visiting student I am bound by Kingston University rules and regulations. Any outstanding debts that I have to Kingston University at the end of my study period will result in the non-release of grades which could affect my progression at my home institution.
- 2. I am responsible for ensuring that I comply with UK immigration rules and requirements.
- 3. If I am coming to study for less than six months I need to choose whether to come to the UK as a Student Visitor or a Tier 4 Adult Student. I must check whether I am considered a visa national or not as this will affect what is mandatory and what is optional for me. Student visitors are not permitted to work (whether paid or unpaid or an internship or volunteering) and cannot extend their stay in the UK.
- 4. If I am coming for more than 6 months I am required to apply for Entry Clearance to the UK as a Tier 4 Adult Student.
- 5. If I am a national of the European Economic Area or Switzerland, I do not require an immigration letter or visa.
- 6. I am required to ensure that I have adequate travel, personal belongings and medical insurance cover for the length of my stay in the United Kingdom. I am responsible for arranging and paying for my travel to and from the programme. I must register online to use the free airport pick-up (details will be emailed to you).
- Kingston University will endeavour to arrange accommodation for me provided that I complete and return the Accommodation Application information by the required deadline. I am responsible for payment of my housing costs.
